Highlights:

Day 1: Depart: Friday 1 September: Depart from the USA and SA to Heathrow/London or Gatwick.

Day 2: Saturday 2 September: Explore London city and see Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square. Free time for lunch at London Eye area with an optional trip on the London Eye. We continue our tour by boat to visit the Tower of London.

Day 3: Sunday 3 September: Discover the iconic landmarks, architectural and cultural diversity, and fascinating history that makes London the most visited city in the world. We see: the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Buckingham Palace, Westminster Chapel, John Wesley's Chapel, the graves of Susanna Wesley, John Bunyan, Daniel Defoe and other famous personages as well as Charles Spurgeon Metropolitan Tabernacle.

Day 4: Monday 4 September: We visit the Georgian city of Bath, Bristol, the New Room, Wesley's first chapel and orphanage museum of George Mueller.

Day 5: Tuesday 5 September: We visit Cardiff Castle, Swansea, the Bible School of Rees Howells, Loughor to visit Moriah Chapel the site of the 1904 Revival.

Day 6: Wednesday 6 September: We travel via Tre'r-ddol in Machynlleth to Bala in the Snowdonia Mountains, Beddgelert and Conwy at the castle.

Day 7: Thursday 7 September: Brief tour of Dublin for an introduction to the beautiful capital, St. Patrick's Cathedral and historic Trinity College.

Day 8: Friday 8 September: Brief tour of Belfast. With a stop at the Belfast Peace Wall and some sites linked with CS Lewis and the Titanic before we travel to - Ahoghill, Ballymena, Coleraine, Connor and Kells, Ballymena.

Day 9: Saturday 9 September: We visit Shottskirk, Glasgow, St George Square with its monuments and Cambuslang.

Day 10: Sunday 10 September: We visit Loch Lomond, Glencoe Valley, Loch Lynne and Loch Ness.

Day 11: Monday 11 September: We catch the ferry to the Island of Lewis to visit the area of the Hebrides Revival. Visit the Barvas Free Church.

Day 12: Tuesday 12 September: We visit Ullapool and head southwest, Pitlochry, Dundee and St Andrews before we arrive at Edinburgh.

Day 13: Wednesday 13 September: We visit John Knox House, explore Edinburgh and see: the Stately Royal Mile, ancient St Giles Cathedral, New Town, Charlotte Chapel. We have some free time for shopping, and to see the place of the Covenanters and the statue of Bobby the dog. Farewell dinner.

Day 14: Thursday 14 September: We travel back to the USA/SA with memories that will last a lifetime.
